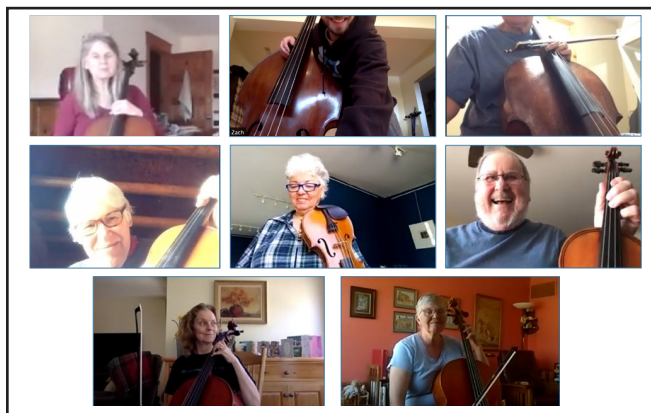
Orchestral Instrument Clinics
